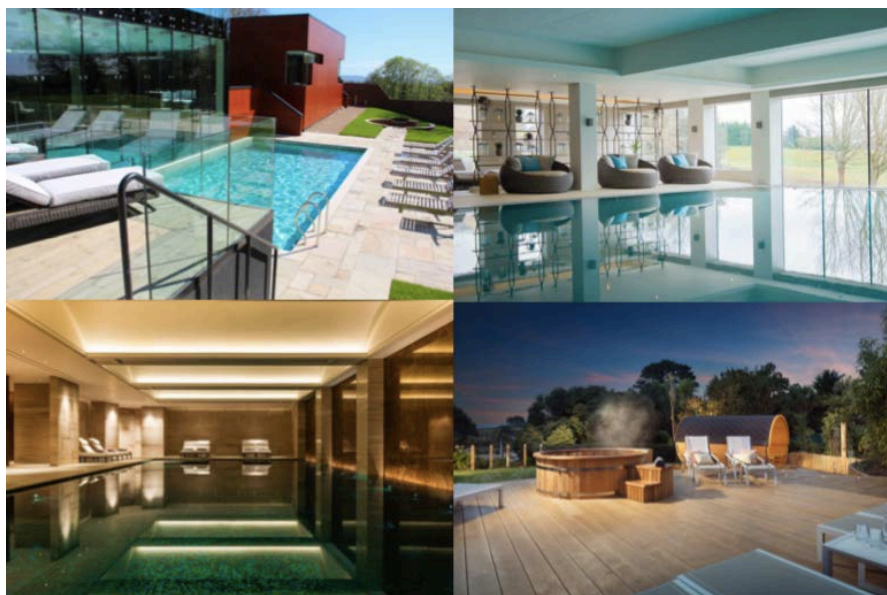


## The Luxury Spa Edit Launches Wellness for Heroes
