Lockdown? What lockdown? Salons and spas can still train with CACI

Despite a second month-long lockdown in the UK beginning this Thursday 5th November, CACI head office in Elstree will remain open for training, encouraging salons and spas to use the opportunity to send staff on CACI training.

‘We’re encouraging our accounts to use this period to get their staff fully trained in all of CACI’s latest treatments and innovations, safe in the knowledge that their attendance on training is not going to clash with their appointment diary,’ says Dean Nathanson, Managing Director at CACI International.

Government guidelines also state that employees can undertake training whilst furloughed, giving them an opportunity to upskill and be up to speed on their return to work.

CACI International has taken extra measures to ensure that training is delivered in a COVID-secure way. Training groups have been reduced in size to ensure social distancing. On arrival, delegates scan the NHS QR code track and trace, complete a mandatory health questionnaire, as well as have their temperature taken.

Hand sterilising stations are located throughout the building for their use, and surgical masks and visors are supplied (all PPE compliant) and worn at all times during training. CACI ensures two metre separation between delegates during the theory sessions, while screen dividers are provided in the training rooms and breakout areas. CACI also ensures that all contact touch points are sanitised every three hours throughout the day.
